## **CLUB PURPOSE & VALUES**

## **BRIEF HISTORY**

- The club was formed by Foundation member Ted Anderson in 1937 with the amalgamation of the Kedron and Wooloowin Past Pupils' Football Associations.
- The club trained and played at Melrose Park, Kalinga for many years before moving to Gibson Park at Stafford.
- In 1963 the club took out a seven-year lease on land at 24 Mercer Avenue, Kedron which had been a rubbish tip and which was later named Mercer Park.
  - In 1970, a further 28 year lease was granted, taken out by the Queensland Australian Football League.

AFL Queensland affiliated Leagues operate in accordance with the AFL Queensland policies, rules and procedures except in situations where local by-laws take precedence over AFL Queensland policies, rules and procedures.

In situations where local affiliated League by-laws are silent then, at the discretion of the League, AFL Queensland policies, rules and procedures apply.

To maintain the integrity of the game at all times the policies, rules and procedures are reviewed annually in consultation with stakeholders and in keeping with changes to the expectations of the AFL and broader community.

Step 1: Place Goal posts in the appropriate 💥 at either end of the playing field from the equipment shed. Large goal posts in the inner two 🗱 and Small goal posts on the outer two 💥 -Please insure that you are on the inner marked oval.

Step 2: Place playing markers on all 4x 3<sup>rd</sup> markers & 2x halfway markers

Step 3: Place markers approximately 5x steps apart from 3<sup>rd</sup> marker to 3<sup>rd</sup> marker on the opposite side of the playing field

Step 4: Place markers around the perimeter of the oval approximately 5x steps apart.



# **UNDER 11 MIXED - HOME GROUND LAYOUT**



All Under 11 Mixed play on a 130 x 90 metre playing surface

All makers and temporary goal posts & field markers are located in the equipment shed

This will be marked on the oval with a series of blue **%**'s Please select the marked blue goal square and **%**'s for the centre line

Step 1: Place temporary goal posts in the appropriate \*\* at opposite end to the clubhouse. Large goal posts in the inner two (goal posts) \*\* and small goal posts on the outer two (behind posts) \*\*

Step 2: Goal post pads from the first aid shed need to go on all goal posts at both ends of the playing field.

Step 3:Place a large orange witches hat on 2x halfway markers on either side of the ground

Step 4: Place markers around the perimeter of the oval walking an arch from centre witches hat to each behind post approximately 8x steps apart including interchange and official's box

## GAME DAY VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

At some stage your Team Manager will call upon you to undertake a particular official task, which may include:

# Ground Marshall Game Day Role a Responsibilities SEQ INNOIS

#### - Ground Marshall

The Home Club shall be responsible for crowd control through their Ground Marshall at all official matches.

Please ensure that if you are the first home game of the day that the Marsh AFL Matchday Checklist (Ground Marshall Checklist) has been completed.

Act as an Umpire escort, responsible for escorting Umpires on and off the ground at the start, half time and end of the match.

Ensure the games commence at designated times, in consultation with the Umpires.

Ground Marshall's must wear a fluorescent green bib (available and signed for from the club canteen) and enclosed footwear.

For further information please refer to Ground Marshall Handbook behind the counter at the canteen

### - Time Keeper

At any season fixture match, it is desirable that each team supply one (1) Timekeeper.

Timekeepers must agree on time prior to the siren being sounded. The siren must sound until acknowledged by the field umpire.

#### **QUARTER LENGTHS**

Under 8, 9, 10 & 11 Girls

4x 10 minutes

Under 11 Mixed

4x 15 minutes

#### **BREAKS**

Under 8, 9, 10 & 11 Girls

1/4 time = 3 minutes

½ time = 6 minutes

3/4 time = 3 minutes

Under 11 Mixed

1/4 time = 5 minutes

½ time = 10 minutes

3/4 time = 5 minutes





## GAME DAY VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

#### - Goal Umpire

Each competing team must provide a Goal Umpire and they must wear a Blue Bib provided by the Team Manager

For further information please refer to Job Role Cards in your team kit (Team Manager), Team Managers Handbook or behind the counter at the canteen

For all Youth games the 2x goal umpires will be required to enter the score onto a score card and hand it to the field umpire on the completion of the game. All scorecards are provided by the field umpire.

#### Team Runner & Water Carriers

Both Team Runner and Water Carriers are permitted in Youth games only.

The Team Runner (1x per team) must wear the Pink Bib and the Water Carriers (max of 4x per team) must be wearing the White Bib/s provided by the Team Manager.
